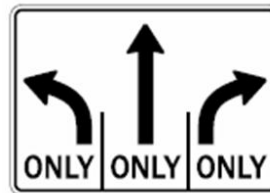

Longitudinal Placement

Unobstructed view of traffic signs.

Clear Visibility Distance:

Should be clear of obstructions to the sight line, whether caused by:

- vegetation,
- other signs or
- street furniture.

The higher the prevailing traffic speeds, the greater this distance needs to be.

Table 1-1 Minimum clear visibility distances

85th percentile speed of private cars (mph)	Minimum clear visibility distance (metres)
Up to 20 30 Km/h	45
21 to 30 48 Km/h	60
31 to 40 64 Km/h	60
41 to 50 80 Km/h	75
51 to 60 96 Km/h	90
Over 60 96 Km/h	105 (120)
